PTO Membership Update

- Trunks will close at 6:45 p.m. so those families will have time to enjoy the other activities.
- We have three teachers who have volunteered to read spooky stories at 5:30 (Seeburger), 6:15 (Kathryn Curran), 7:00 (Kayla Mabe).
- We have a map with everything numbered so families will know where everything is. There will be a large map at the entrance with a QR code as well.
- Volunteers will meet at the PTO shed. There will be water and snacks for volunteers, and flashlights so people can identify those who are volunteering.
- We do have toy items for children with allergies in teal buckets at each trunk.

 There is a \$30 vendor fee, and we ask them to donate a \$20 silent auction item.
- A volunteer sign up will be going out soon. Please consider signing up to help. If we do not get enough volunteers, there is a chance we will need to scale back or cancel this event. We know December seems far away, so please look at your schedules and consider helping for a small portion of the event.
- We are having a book drive this year and encourage families to donate books.
 Families can bring books to donate, or purchase books at the Book Fair to donate. The books will be dispersed later on in the year.
- We are bringing in a vendor to do the Elf Shop this year. They will bring all the inventory and price the items. Kids will be able to shop with their elf helper again this year and will be given an envelope telling their elf how much money they have to spend. There will be a time limit so parents are not left waiting too long.
- There will be one location, likely toward the entrance, where you can use cash to purchase Scrooge Bucks to use throughout the festival. Cash will only be accepted at this location. We will also accept PayPal and Venmo if you don't have cash to buy Scrooge Bucks.
- At a minimum, we will need about ten adults to volunteer the Friday evening before the event to help set up, and approximately sixty adults to help the day of the event. Please consider volunteering in some capacity!
